## Details of Co-Curricular Activities

### Our Objectives:

1. We believe in promoting an all-rounder growth and development in our students. Apart from academic pursuits, co-curricular activities (CCA) can help students to identify, realize their talents and hone their skillsets.
2. To inculcate values, instil discipline, responsibility and accountability in developing self-worth, self-love, self-respect which are key in confidence building and leadership development.
3. CCA works in parallel with Tzu Chi Humanistic Culture Education in helping students to build a strong moral compass within. CCA provides added opportunity for students to co-mingle and collaborate from which they develop interpersonal skills and team spirit, exercise respect, love, and gratitude, and conduct themselves with compassion and loving kindness to coexist with others in unity and harmony. Meanwhile, CCA helps shape positive characters such as grit, humility and zest. It is therefore the school policy to implement the system of :
  - I. 'One Student, One Sport' in encouraging students to adopt and maintain a life style of healthy physical and mental wellbeing.
  - II. 'One Student, Two Clubs' which will enable students to identify and harness their skills and talents through varied engaging activities and club choices.

### Terms and Regulations:

1. CCA will be conducted every Monday, Wednesday, and Friday, from 3:10 PM – 4:30 PM (Primary) and 3:30 PM – 5:00 PM (Secondary) during school term except on public holidays.
2. Each student is required to choose ONE sport and TWO clubs. They can make their choices at the start of each school year.
3. Students will need to select three (3) preferred sports, activities and clubs for each of the three (3) CCA Days.
4. The allocation of sport, activities and clubs will be based on your choice of preference, subject to availability:
  - Allocation will be based on first-come, first-served basis. However, preference will be given to those who are representatives or award winners in the chosen field.



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- TCISKL reserves the right to review and revise any decision/s made on the allocation of activities once an activity has exceeded its limited number of participants.
  - There is a minimum enrolment of 20 students for each sport, activity and club. Any of these activities which failed to meet the minimum number of student enrolment will be dropped or discontinued.
  - Students are not allowed to make any changes to their choice of activity within the academic year except for those with approval based on valid medical reasons.
5. Fees for any combination of three (3) activities for the 3 CCA days are:
- RM120 per month for Primary Students, to be paid for a full 12-month academic year.
  - RM150 per month for Secondary Students, to be paid for a full 12-month academic year.
6. CCA fees will be invoiced together with Tuition Fees on a quarterly basis and to be paid in advance.
7. In addition to CCA fees, students are required to pay for all other charges related to activities of their choice. This may include necessary material/s, uniform, instrument/s, fees charged for competition or examination. Parents are advised to take note of such additional fees prior to confirming their child's choice of activities.
8. All CCA will be conducted within the school compound unless otherwise advised by the school.
9. Students must strictly follow the dress code as specified for each activity.
10. Students must fully observe all rules and regulations, exercise discipline and behave respectfully towards all teachers, instructors and coaches.
11. Students must be punctual for all activities and no early dismissal is allowed unless it is for valid medical or emergency reasons.
12. Any absenteeism without valid reason and prior consent will be taken negatively.
13. There will not be any replacement of classes or refund of fees in cases of absenteeism, with or without cause.
